



If your enrollment level is affected by Mini Term B classes, your initial Pell Grant award will be based on classes **taken** during the full semester, plus Mini term 1 classes only. The balance from your full term and Mini term 1 classes will be disbursed during the first disbursement period (14 days after the beginning of the Fall term) once your Participant Attendance Voucher (PAV) has been received.

The increased Pell Grant award, which includes Mini Term 2, will be available for use on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Mini Term 2. Disbursement of Pell Grant funds for Mini Term 2 will be within fourteen (14) days after the beginning of that term.

Example:

Registration for fall = 12 credit hours

Of the 12 credit hours,

Full term = 6 credit hours

Mini Term A = 3 credit hours

Mini Term B = 3 credit hours

Total = 12 credit hours

Pell Grant award for full term (assuming maximum benefit) would be \$2366. However, your initial award would be based on the full term classes and the Mini Term A classes, which would make your **initial award** \$1775 (3/4 time award). When enrollment in Mini Term 2 begins, the increased Pell Grant amount can be used for tuition, fees, books, and supplies for that term.
