

LAWSON STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE FALL 2011 GED TEST SCHEDULE

GED:

Purpose: Allows adults who have not graduated from high school the opportunity to earn a high school diploma.

Registration is required before individuals may take the GED Test. All candidates should come to the Leon Kennedy Student Center, second floor, Room F 220 at 9:00 a.m. with proper documentation. Registration is on a first come, first served basis.

Candidates planning to test for the first time should note the following:

1. Pre-pay a required fee (\$50.00 for first time examinees) in the Business Office. The Business Office is located in the Administration Building (2nd floor). Individuals retaking the GED test must pay \$10.00 for each exam.
2. All applicants must present their U.S. Social Security Number (SSAN) which will be used within all record keeping systems for the purpose of identification verification. Applicants must also present to the GED Examiner a valid government identification card that includes the applicant's photograph, legal name, birth date, address, and signature. A current identification card issued by a member institution of the Alabama Community College System is also acceptable as long as the applicant's photograph, name, birth date, address, and signature are included. Expired or altered identification documents are unacceptable.
3. Bring receipt and proper identification to the Leon Kennedy Student Center, Room 221. Registration for the GED test begins promptly at 9:00 a.m. and will take approximately 1 ½ hours to complete. Individuals not attending the registration session **will not** be permitted to take the GED test.

The GED test begins promptly at 8:00 a.m. and requires five to eight hours to complete. Examinees should be prepared to stay all day. Examinees may bring a lunch or eat lunch in the campus cafeteria.

Individuals with disabilities may require special test administrations. Such individuals should discuss their needs with Ms. Shirley Barnes (205-929-2113) and complete an L-15 form prior to registration.
