

**LAWSON STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
GED TEST SCHEDULE - SPRING 2010**

GED TEST:

Registration is required before individuals may take the GED Test. All candidates should appear in person with proper documentation at the Birmingham Campus, A. G. Gaston Building auditorium. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. Candidates who are planning to test for the first time must:

1. Pre-pay the required fee (**\$50.00 for first time examinees**) in the Business Office. Located in the Administration Building (2nd floor). Candidates who are **retaking** the examination must pay **\$10.00 for each exam**.
2. All applicants must present their **U.S. Social Security card (SSAN)** that will be used in all record keeping systems for the purpose of identification verification. You must also present to the GED Examiner a valid government identification card that includes your photograph, legal name, birth date, address, and signature. A current identification card issued by a member institution of the Alabama College System is also acceptable as long as your photograph, name, birth date, address, and signature are included. **Expired or altered identification documents are not acceptable.**
3. Bring receipt, proper identification to the A.G. Gaston Building auditorium. Registration for the GED examination begins promptly at 10:00 a.m. and will take about 2 1/2 hours to complete. Individuals who do not attend the registration session will not be permitted to take the test on the date given.

The GED Test begins promptly at 8:00 a.m. and requires five to eight hours to complete. Examinees should be prepared to stay all day. Bring a lunch or eat lunch in the cafeteria on campus. Individuals who due to a disability requiring special test administration should complete an L-15 before the test date.
