TITLE	Standards of Academic Progress: Transfer Students
LEGAL AUTHORITY	State Board of Education Policy 714.03
DATE APPROVED BY BOARD	March 23, 2000

A transfer student who is admitted on Clear academic status is subject to the same standards of academic progress as a "native" student. Grades accrued at other regionally accredited postsecondary institutions are not included in GPA calculation.

A transfer student who is admitted on Academic Probation retains that status until the student has attempted at least 12 semester credit hours at the institution. If, at the conclusion of the semester in which the student has attempted a total of 12 or more semester credit hours at the institution, the Cumulative GPA at the institution is below 1.5, the student is suspended for one semester. The transcript will read SUSPENDED--ONE SEMESTER.

If, at the conclusion of the semester in which the transfer student admitted on Academic Probation has attempted a total of 12 semester credit hours at the institution, the Cumulative GPA at the institution is 1.5 or above, the student's status is Clear.

Athens State University

1. A transfer student who is admitted with a Cumulative GPA of less than 2.0 will be admitted on Academic Probation. If, at the conclusion of the semester in which the transfer student admitted on Probation has attempted a total of 12 semester credit hours at the institution, and the Cumulative GPA at the institution is 2.0 or above, the student's status is Clear.
2. If, at the conclusion of the semester in which the transfer student admitted on Probation has attempted a total of 12 semester credit hours at the institution, and the Semester GPA at the institution is 2.0 or above, but the Cumulative GPA is less than 2.0, the student will remain on Academic Probation.
3. If, at the conclusion of the semester in which the transfer student admitted on Probation has attempted a total of 12 semester credit hours at the institution, and the Semester GPA at the institution is less than 2.0, the student is suspended for one semester. The transcript will read SUSPENDED - ONE SEMESTER.
