The principles enumerated below are the cornerstones of Lawson State Community College's instructional integrity.

1. We believe that student retention should be aimed at educational accomplishment rather than merely retaining students for purposes of fiscal reimbursement by the State.
2. We believe that academic standards must not be lowered to retain students.
3. We believe that all components of the Institution, not just faculty, are responsible for student retention.
4. We accept the responsibility of the faculty to encourage and assist students in the completion of any college work undertaken.
5. We accept responsibility in helping to ensure the success of our students and thereby counsel and advise students toward the correct steps to reach their goal.
