

What is the Community College Bridge Program?

Miles College is collaborating with Lawson State Community College (LSCC) to foster higher degree production in the STEM disciplines.

The **STEM** disciplines are **Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics.**

The program is designed to ensure the success of STEM students that transfer to Miles College.

LSCC Students completing the Associate Degree will enter Miles College with Junior status.

Students will have the opportunity to participate in both the Research Experience for Undergraduate program and GRE preparation and application process.

Students must be accepted to Miles College prior to their acceptance into the Bridge Program.

Select students will be afforded scholarships and research training during the transition from LSCC to Miles.
