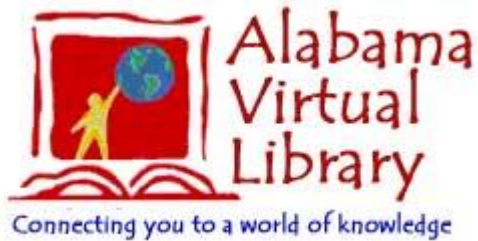


About the Alabama Virtual Library

Users must visit their local Alabama public library, public K-12 school library, or public postsecondary library to obtain an AVL Home Access Card with a username and password.
