

**Notes from the October 2, 2006 meeting with personnel from the
Jefferson County Roads and Transportation Department**

Projects were reviewed with an emphasis on the work that remains to be done on the
Birmingham Campuses of Lawson State.

- Residence Hall – grading, gutters, paving, parking and curbing remain. Shields and Corley will meet with the Rob B. B. (project superintendent) and discuss a start date for this work to begin.
- Left over soil will be moved to the low spots in front of the residence hall.
- Culverts on west campus behind elementary school will be extended from the west side of Wenonah Elementary to Oak Avenue. The two large pipes that are exposed are a hazard particularly with the elementary students.
- Shields will consult with Tim Roberts, LYBD, to verify whether or not the Corps of Engineers will need to determine jurisdiction before the culvert can be extended. The concern is whether or not the area is considered to be wetland.
- The work remaining on the rear access drive to the Leon Kennedy Center includes the binding coat for the asphalt.
- The work remaining on the parking area adjacent to the Ward Technology Building and the Shores Building includes paving and binding for the asphalt.
