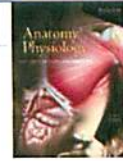

1. A halo- or crownlike structure, as in the corona radiata or the coronal suture of the skull.
 3. Pertaining to the ribs.
 6. Pertaining to a tall or narrow tail-like part of an organ.
 7. The rounded bony dome that forms the roof of the cranium; skullcap.
 8. A thin layer, such as the lamina of a vertebra or the lamina propria of a mucous membrane.
 10. A blade-like plate of hyaline cartilage that attaches the distal end

1. A rounded knob on a bone serving to produce smooth motion at a joint.
 2. The gelatinous center of an intervertebral disc.
 4. An organ system consisting of the bones, ligaments, bone marrow, periosteum, articular cartilages, and other tissues associated with the bones.
 5. A hole through a bone or other organ, in many cases providing passage for blood vessels and nerves.
