Lawson State Community College recently applied for federal stimulus dollars that may be available to Alabama. We have proposed an Allied Health Training facility on the Bessemer campus. This proposal includes RN, LPN, Nurse Assistant, Home Health Aide, Emergency Medical Technicians, and Dental Assistant programs. These programs are listed as high demand occupations in Central Alabama and the College is diligently working to expand these programs in the City of Bessemer. It will be a great asset for the campus and the community to have these diverse allied health training programs.

Please join me on Friday, January 30, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. in the conference room of the Ethel Hall Building, just across the street from UAB Medical West. We will meet to discuss expansion of these programs and the possible design and construction of a new Allied Health Building on the Bessemer campus.
