### 1. General Education Core

The Chancellor shall define and establish a core of general education courses for each formal award authorized by the State Board of Education. The courses of the core may be used to complete degree and graduation requirements.

- A. Courses of the core of general education courses shall be transferable between and among the colleges and shall meet requirements as specified within this policy.
- B. The Chancellor shall recommend the core of general education courses to the State Board of Education for approval.
- C. The Chancellor shall review the core of general education courses at least once every three years. Recommendations shall be made, when appropriate, to the State Board of education for adding courses to or deleting courses from the core. In the event of a statewide articulation agreement that defines a general education core, the Chancellor shall have the authority to make the changes necessary for the general education core courses to conform to the requirements of such statewide articulation agreement with notice to the State Board of Education.
