Reciprocal library privileges for students, faculty and staff, including the borrowing of materials, reference services and use of facilities will be extended.


Students, faculty and staff who wish to borrow materials from the library shall provide a valid institution identification card and a current driver's license.

Each library shall retain authority to establish its own policies regarding materials usage and library use and operation.

Individual patrons will be held responsible for all materials borrowed. Each library agrees to inform the borrowing institution's Business Office of overdue, damaged or lost materials. Additionally, the lending institution agrees to notify the borrowing institution's Business Office of resolved patron accounts in order to clear blocked records.

Each library has the right to revoke library privileges from patrons violating any policies or procedures.


This agreement shall be evaluated annually by both libraries and may be modified as needed.
