The Admissions Appeals Committee reviewed your admission file including your letter of appeal and supporting documents such as your application for admission and your prior college transcript(s). Based on the recommendation of the Admissions Appeals Committee, your appeal for admission to the 2008 fall semester has been approved. You have been admitted to Lawson State Community College on academic probation and your academic performance in subsequent semesters must meet the satisfactory academic progress standards at our institution defined in our current college catalog.

Federal and state regulations require that all students at Lawson State Community College meet minimum standards of satisfactory academic progress to receive financial aid. Academic progress standards required by the Office of Student Financial Services are pre-determined for federal financial aid eligibility. Your admission on appeal does not imply aid eligibility for this semester or future semesters. Registration for fall semester occurs August 18 and 19, 2008 from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on either campus. You will see a counselor to register for classes. Please register for classes on the campus you will *primarily* attend. On the Bessemer campus, please visit Building A, Student Services Suite to register. On the Birmingham campus, please visit the Arthur Shores Fine Arts Building (gym) to register. You may come anytime between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

You may be required to take the Compass placement assessment depending upon your program of study, award type, and whether or not you earned applicable transfer credits in specific courses. Compass placement assessments will be available on August 18th and 19th. Please bring a valid photo identification card such as your driver's license to the assessment session.
