QUALIFICATIONS

- Admission application on file
- Scholarship application on file
- First Time Freshman: High school applicants must have a grade point average of 2.75 or above, on a 4.0 scale. An official high school transcript is required including the date of high school graduation and the cumulative high school grade point average.
- Currently Enrolled Students: Currently enrolled students with 12-44 hours in courses designated 100 level or above must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above, on a 4.0 scale. A Lawson State Community College transcript is required.
- Transfer Student: Transfer applicants must be enrolled at Lawson State Community College one semester prior to making application for scholarship and complete 12 semester hours in courses designated 100 level or above. The applicant must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above, on a 4.0 scale in the course work completed at Lawson State Community College. A Lawson State Community College transcript is required.

The academic scholarship pays for tuition. The student is responsible for his or her books and required fees. Students on academic scholarship are required to take a minimum of 12 semester hours each semester, fall and spring; summer is optional. Students must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher each semester to remain on academic scholarship. Students who are on academic scholarship and who fail to enroll in either the fall or spring semesters or who do not maintain the necessary grade point averages forfeit their academic scholarship. Students who forfeit their academic scholarship may reapply after completing 12 semester hours in courses designated 100 level or above and earning the grade point averages described in the section for Currently Enrolled Students.

APPLICATIONS ARE REVIEWED BASED ON INFORMATION PROVIDED ON THE TRANSCRIPT AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. THE SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW COMMITTEE REVIEWS ALL APPLICATIONS TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE END OF EACH SEMESTER. THEREFORE, ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE BEFORE THE SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW COMMITTEE MEETS.
