

Career & Technical Education (CTE) Tuition & Fee Waiver

The Career and Technical Education (CTE) Tuition Fee Waivers are for outstanding Career and Technical Program students. The waiver covers **UP TO ONE** year of tuition and fees only (no other expenses). Eligible candidates are those who are seeking enrollment in a postsecondary institution in a Career/Technical program that is a two-year Associate Degree program or less (certificate) and have a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or higher. Newly enrolled GED Recipients may receive two free courses, upon completion of the current semester courses earning a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or higher, student may then qualify for the full Career & Technical Education (CTE) Tuition & Fee Waiver.

The approximate number of Career and Technical Waivers are offered each academic semester based on the remaining institutional scholarships.

To qualify for the Career and Technical Tuition Fee Waiver the following is required:

- (1) pursue a CTE training program requiring two years (Associates degree) or less for completion
- (2) a COMPLETE admission application
- (3) the last semester attended showing a 2.50 or above cumulative grade point average
- (4) the complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- (5) All materials must be on file before the April 15th deadline date. Applicants will be notified of their financial aid award package including all scholarships, grants, and work-study on or before July 30th.

Examples of CTE Programs: Auto-Body, Auto-Mechanics, Barbering, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts, Dental Assistant, Diesel Mechanics, Graphics and Design, Industrial Electronics, Licensed Practical Nurse, Media Production, Plumbing, Robotics, Welding
