- Earn IRS certification as a volunteer tax preparer
- No prior tax knowledge or experience required
- Gain professional client interaction skills valuable for your resume and career

- Provide free tax preparation for working families and help them to **save an average of \$400 per return** on commercial preparation fees - money and savings that go directly to their children's education, housing, transportation to school and jobs, and savings and asset-building
